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**RULES FOR AWARDING THE BACHELOR'S DEGREE
IN THE GOVERNANCE OF ORGANIZATIONS (GOO) PROGRAM**

I. Basic documents defining the general rules for awarding the degree

II. Description of the rules for awarding the degree in the Governance of Organizations program

BACHELOR'S THESIS

1. The thesis should correspond to the student's academic interests and to the research profile of the relevant Department/Unit at Collegium Polonicum.
2. The title and scope of the thesis are determined by the supervisor or the student and must be approved by the Program Council of the MoDE and GOO programs.
3. The thesis should constitute a focused study of research material and meet specified methodological requirements.
4. In the thesis, the student must demonstrate the ability to prepare and edit an academic text.
5. The thesis should include a detailed list of academic literature and source materials on which it is based. The literature should be current and substantively significant.
6. The thesis should meet standard editorial and formal requirements.
7. References to the views of other authors must be indicated in accordance with citation rules applicable to academic works.





8. The thesis should be written in English and demonstrate linguistic and stylistic correctness.
9. The use of artificial intelligence tools in the process of preparing the bachelor's thesis is permitted in accordance with the regulations in force at Adam Mickiewicz University, Poznań and in consultation with the thesis supervisor.
10. The thesis should be approximately 30 pages in length.
11. Criteria for the assessment of the bachelor's thesis:
 - a) Relevance of the content of the thesis in relation to the topic formulated in the title.
 - b) Organization and structure of the thesis.
 - c) Substantive content.
 - d) Language quality.
 - e) Selection of sources and the manner of their use.
 - f) Formal aspects of the thesis.

A change of thesis supervisor or thesis title requires the approval of the Program Council of the MoDE and GOO programs.

The process of registering the bachelor's thesis, as well as its review and submission for the defense, is governed by the rules adopted at Adam Mickiewicz University (APD system).

The bachelor's examination must be taken no later than three months after the submission of the bachelor's thesis; exceeding this deadline results in removal from the list of students.

The examination committee consists of three members: the chairperson, the thesis supervisor, and the thesis reviewer.

Examination questions are based on the catalogue of examination topics for the Governance of Organizations program. During the examination, the student presents the main theses of the bachelor's thesis and answers three questions from the catalogue of examination topics and one question related to the issues addressed in the bachelor's thesis.





FINAL GRADE ON THE DIPLOMA

The diploma grade is determined on the basis of three components:

- a) 3/5 of the average of all grades obtained during the course of study;
- b) 1/5 of the grade for the diploma thesis, calculated as the average of the grades awarded by the supervisor and the reviewer;
- c) 1/5 of the final grade of the diploma examination.

The final result and its individual components are calculated to two decimal places..

Confirmation of passing the diploma examination is provided by a protocol signed by all members of the examination committee. On this basis, the diploma of graduation is issued.
